**Description of the location**

Coastal Lodge provides 35 community short term beds for Rehabilitation, Reablement and End of Life Care. The property is located in a quiet residential area of Bournemouth, close to local amenities, set in mature gardens and has recently been refurbished and refitted. The client accommodation is arranged over two floors divided into four ‘cottages’ each having 10 bedrooms, communal W.C.’s and wet rooms together with lounge/dining areas.

A multi-disciplinary team of staff work with clients and/or carers to achieve agreed outcomes which can include improving and maintaining daily living skills, promoting health and wellbeing and enabling clients to remain as independent as possible.

We also have clinical and therapy support services that are provided by community based healthcare professionals.

We are registering to allow the service to be regulated in the treatment of disease, disorder or injury to allow us to increase the amount of clinical support and care to people.

Fire Procedures are in place and include, regular fire drills, testing of equipment, annual risk assessments and staff training.

Equipment is provided to meet the assessed needs of clients.

Staff receive regular training in Supporting Carers with medicines including regular competency assessments.

Tricuro has a complaints and compliments policy and procedure

Our recruitment processes are robust. New employees do not commence until all necessary checks are undertaken. Tricuro is an equal opportunities employer and we have a full interview process in place.

We manage our staffing ratio according to care requirements and the needs of the clients, working in a person centred way at all times, as either part of a planned service or as an emergency immediate response visit.

Staff from both services attend the five-day Adult Care Services Care Certificate training. A range of other courses which include Safe handling of medication, Moving and Handling; Health and Safety; First aid; Continence Support; Infection control; Physical disabilities; Sensory loss; Dementia; Working with diversity; Safeguarding Adults; Managing challenging behaviour; Diabetes; Mental Capacity Act and DOLS, Bereavement and loss.
